3	Applicant sends Emergency Management, <a href="#">Jared Schneider</a> , an electronic copy of all required certificates. This can be completed within 6 months of application.	EM may have classroom ICS classes available.
4	Emergency Management will review application for completion.	EM process
5	Emergency Management will send applicant the link for a Background Check. Applicant will complete required information, including SSN, and submit online. Emergency Management will process paperwork and Background Check. Emergency Worker ID printed	EM process – your SSN will be required
6	Attend an Issaquah Emergency Worker Orientation and receive your Issaquah Emergency Worker ID Card.	EM
