1	Obtain or have Emergency Management e-mail to you the City of Issaquah Emergency Worker application packet. Complete Emergency Operations Management Adult Volunteer Service Agreement for CERT Complete Emergency Worker Registration Card (EMD 024) Ensure all spaces are filled/legible particularly Driver's License No List all training completed even if not required Receive Personal Responsibilities of Emergency Workers (WAC 118-04-200) Photo for the Emergency Worker ID will be taken at this time	Obtain packet from Jared Schneider jareds@issaquahwa.gov Return to: Emergency Management Jared Schneider jareds@issaquahwa.gov
2	Start completing basic and online requirements: O CERT Class or IS 317 or Emergency Preparedness Class IS 100: https://training.fema.gov/is/courseoverview.aspx?code=IS-100.b IS 700: http://training.fema.gov/is/courseoverview.aspx?code=IS-700.a O CPR/AED/First Aid (must be renewed every two years)	FEMA will require a Student ID Number in lieu of the SS# for every test so get your SID at: https://cdp.dhs.gov/femasid
3	Applicant sends Emergency Management, <u>Jared Schneider</u> , an electronic copy of all required certificates. This can be completed within 6 months of application.	EM may have classroom ICS classes available.
4	Emergency Management will review application for completion.	EM process
5	Emergency Management will send applicant the link for a Background Check. Applicant will complete required information, including SSN, and submit online. Emergency Management will process paperwork and Background Check. Emergency Worker ID printed	EM process – your SSN will be required
6	Attend an Issaquah Emergency Worker Orientation and receive your Issaquah Emergency Worker ID Card.	EM
